

OPEN CALL

Design of the façade of the former mini golf house in the newly designed 'Konschtpark' in Clervaux.

The municipality of Clervaux and the Cité de l'Image invite artists, photographers and illustrators to develop a concept for the artistic design of the façade of the former mini golf house and the exterior wall in the public space of Clervaux.

THEME

The project focuses on photography as an artistic medium. We are looking for creative approaches that make photography visible, reinterpret it or allow it to enter into dialogue with the urban space and the population.

OBJECTIVE

The artwork should:

- reflect the photographic tradition and significance of the Cité de l'Image in Clervaux,
- enhance the former mini golf house and the exterior wall as an identity-forming element in the urban space,
- be contemporary, innovative and sustainable in design.

BUDGET

A total budget of €25,000 (including VAT) is available for the realisation of the project.

This covers the following costs:

- Artist's fee
- Production and materials
- Transport and installation

The municipality of Clerv will provide scaffolding for the project.

CONDITIONS OF PARTICIPATION

- The open call is aimed at national artists (Luxembourg citizens or residents of Luxembourg).
- Applications may be submitted by individuals or collectives.
- Experience with art in public spaces is an advantage but not essential.

DOCUMENTS TO BE SUBMITTED

1. Brief description of the artistic concept (max. two A4 pages)
2. Visualisations/sketches or reference images
3. Technical feasibility description, including choice of materials
4. Budget breakdown (including VAT)
5. CV and portfolio
6. Contact form (available for download on the website)

Documents may be submitted in the following languages: LU / DE / FR or EN

SELECTION PROCESS

A jury consisting of representatives from the municipality of Clervaux, the Cité de l'Image and external experts will select the winning project. The criteria are:

- Artistic quality and originality
- Relevance to the theme of photography
- Relevance to the location of Clervaux
- Feasibility within the budget and time frame
- Sustainability of the materials used

TIMELINE

- Publication of open call: 15 February 2026
- Submission deadline: 31 March 2026
- Jury meeting and selection: April 2026
- Implementation & installation: by agreement, from June 2026 at the earliest

INFORMATION
